Finnish Association of Purchasing and Logistics LOGY's awards recognize the excellent work in the field of procurement and logistics.

The purpose of the annual awards is to promote Finnish competitiveness by supporting the development of purchasing, logistics and supply chains. The aim is to combine the best practices and the development needs from the field with the academic research and education for a continuous development of the procurement and logistics sectors.

Nominate a good candidate for the Award. LOGY rewards companies, experts as well as researchers and students in the field.

LOGY's Procurement and Logistics Awards

LOGY selects and publishes annually the following awards:

- Logistician/Procurement Professional of the Year
- Logistics or Procurement Organisation/Project of the Year
- Procurement/Logistics Research of the Year (PhD)
- Procurement/Logistics Master Thesis of the Year (Master level/University)
- Procurement/Logistics Final Assignment of the Year (University of Applied Science)
- Contractor of the Year
- Subcontractor of the Year
- Intralogistic Organisation/Project of the Year

LOGY does not publish the selection criteria in public.

Additionally, LOGY's forums and regions may award stipends and official recognition of excellence apart from LOGY's general awards in the different categories. An excellent candidate is eligible to receive a recognition from the LOGY and from his/hers own forum or region. LOGY grants the funds to the stipends selected by forums and regions.

Award Categories

Nominations by the end of the March.

CONTRACTOR AND SUBCONTRACTOR OF THE YEAR – RECOGNITIONS

Contractor and Subcontractor of the Year recognitions are given to the companies, that have worked persistently and exemplarily as a contractor and as a subcontractor. The subcontractor awarding committee selects the winner companies among the proposed candidates.

The Contractor and Subcontractor of the Year are published at the Subcontracting Trade Fair in September.

Nominations by the end of the August. The Awarding committee process the candidates in their meeting.

INTRALOGISTIC ORGANISATION / PROJECT OF THE YEAR

Intralogistic Organisation/Project of the Year recognition is given to an organisation or an excellent project in the field of intralogistics, based on the proposal made by the LOGY's Intralogistic Forum Board and decided by the Board of LOGY. Finnish Foundation of Logistics Research (Official Finnish name: Logistiikan tutkimuksen edistämissäätiö LTES) grants the funds to these awards based on the LOGY's application.

Intralogistic Organisation/Project of the Year is published in the LOGY Seminar: Internal Logistics Day (Sisälogistiikkapäivä).

Nominations by the end of the October. The Awarding committee process the candidates in their meetings in autumn.

LOGISTICIAN/PROCUREMENT PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR

Logistician/Procurement Professional of the Year recognition is given to the individual, who is actively involved in the development of the logistic/procurement sector. Logistician/Procurement Professional is rewarded with the badge of merit with red ruby which is endowed by LOGY.

Logistician/Procurement Professional of the Year is published at the LOGY's main annual event, LOGY Conference, in the beginning of February.

Nominations by the end of the October. The Awarding committee process the candidates in their meetings in autumn.

LOGISTIC or PROCUREMENT ORGANISATION / PROJECT OF THE YEAR

Logistic or Procurement project of the Year is recognising the high-level and persistent development or research project or alternatively for the project that generates new innovative and concrete operational and economic benefits.

In the selection process the attention is paid to the following dimensions: innovativeness, effectiveness, social and environmental responsibility, national significance, climate change, carbon footprint and economical sustainability in the operations. All of the above-mentioned criteria do not need to exist at the same time.

Finnish Foundation of Logistics Research (Official Finnish name: Logistiikan tutkimuksen edistämissäätiö LTES) grants the funding for the Logistics or Procurement Project of the year Award.

Nominations by 15th of September. The Awarding committee process the candidates in their meetings in autumn.

PROCUREMENT/LOGISTICS RESEARCH OF THE YEAR

Procurement/Logistics Research of the Years is a recognition of the licentiate- or dissertation level research.

PROCUREMENT/LOGISTICS MASTER THESIS OF THE YEAR

Procurement/Logistics Theses of the Years is a recognition of the master theses level research.

PROCUREMENT/LOGISTICS FINAL ASSIGNMENT OF THE YEAR

Procurement/Logistics Final Assignment of the Year is a recognition of the final paper done in University of the Applied Sciences (YAMK or AMK).

Criteria of evaluation

The theses are evaluated according to the publicly available version. The criteria of evaluation are:

- Alignment/Focus on procurement/logistics sector
- Utilisation in the practise (the results of the theses are utilized for working life and supports the development of the sector)
- Effectiveness (thesis needs to have societal effectiveness included)
- The thesis needs to be academically immaculate (grade at least 80%) especially with master theses.

Application to the competition

A proposal for take part to the competition can be made by the author of the theses or the supervisor. If the supervisor makes a proposal, he/she must have the permission from the author.

Annexes to the application

- Dissertation / Thesis
- Statement prepared by the supervisor/evaluating teacher and the reasons why the thesis is proposed for the competition.

Finnish Foundation of Logistics Research (Official Finnish name: Logistiikan tutkimuksen edistämissäätiö LTES) is granting the funds to the stipends distributed for the authors. All dissertations/theses written from 10/2019 until 9/2020 can take part to the competition.

These awards are published in the member's event in November, which is held in the conjunction with the association's official autumn meeting.

Nomination for the Awards

Candidates may be nominated (excluded Contractor and Subcontractor of the Year awards) by submitting a short, unstructured written proposal. The proposal should be indicated to the Secretariat of the Award Committee by email to: yhdistys@logy.fi.

The Committee can also invite companies, project, individuals, and dissertations/thesis to participate without a separate application.
